Established in 1991, the Augusta Sports Council (ASC) is a local non-profit 501(c)3 organization that serves to strengthen the quality of life and economic wellbeing for the city of Augusta through recruiting, supporting and attracting sporting events.



Additionally, the ASC team seeks to host events which will provide exposure for the Augusta area as a sports destination. Each event assists in enhancing our community by supporting local economic development efforts through sports tourism. Since our start, 800+ events have been supported, recruited, or created by the ASC. From the small to the multi-sport, these events have attracted 450,000+ athletes to the area, leaving behind more than \$200 million in economic impact.

While our work and mission goes beyond any county border, the ASC is primarily funded through a portion of Augusta-Richmond County's accommodations tax revenue, as well as event revenue generated from the Augusta Half Marathon, 10K, & 5K, and sponsorship support during the year.

All-CSRA Football Banquet/Ray Guy Award winner dinner

We are the home of the Ray Guy Award which is presented to the nation's best collegiate punter each year live on ESPN's Home Depot College Football Award Show. The winners of the Ray Guy Award and FCS Award are formally welcomed to our sports family during the January All-CSRA Football Banquet that we co-host with WJBF in January.

The award show is shown live on Channel 6 where four \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to local student athletes on the All-CSRA Football teams.



Augusta Half Marathon, 10K, & 5K FEBRUARY

The 15th annual Augusta Half Marathon, 10K & 5K event is the sports council's only owned sporting event. A local favorite, the 2023 race is expected to welcome 1300+ runners from our area and region on Saturday, February 25, 2023! All 3 race courses are USATF certified and overall and age group awards will be given out. This race also supports local charity partners. After runners run through Downtown Augusta, the Medical District, Summerville, and the Lake Olmstead /Augusta Canal a post race celebration will await them in the Augusta Common!



Medals for Miles Fun Run

The cutest fun run in Augusta will take place on Saturday, February 25, 2023! The Medals for Miles Fun Run is the kid friendly component to the Augusta Half Marathon, 10K & 5K event. The Medals for Miles program is geared for kids ages K-3. Students run, walk, or roll a total of 12 miles in any daily distance prior to the Augusta Half Marathon weekend. On Saturday, February 25th, all participating students will complete their 1.1 mile lap as a group, earning their own Augusta Half Marathon medal and t-shirt!



GAMES Scholarship Progam MAY

As a GAMES Scholarship Program supporter, you are supporting 10 local scholar athletes in the next chapter in their academic career. The GAMES Scholarship began in 2011 as part of the ASC's annual G.A.M.E.S. Awards which was an annual program created to highlight outstanding amateur athletes who represented a broad spectrum of sports disciplines in the area. To date, the Augusta Sports Council has awarded over \$68,000 in college scholarships to 58 graduating high school student athletes in the Augusta community.



IRONMAN 70.3 Augusta** SEPTEMBER

The annual event is considered one of the largest IRONMAN events in North America. About 3,500 participants from all of over the world will swim 1.2 miles in the Savannah River, 56 mile bike through South Augusta, concluding with a 13.1 mile run through Downtown Augusta.

Experience Augusta Celebration

In collaboration with Destination Augusta and Film Augusta, the Experience Augusta Celebration is the annual tourism celebration in our community. Together with our local partners and attractions, the event includes local music, food, highlights of our local hospitality industry's accomplishments throughout the year, and future project announcements coming to our community in the new year!
